Inclement Weather:

In the event of inclement weather is around, we will be monitoring the radar and will make a decision on league promptly. Notification will come via email and phone call in the event the league is needing to be canceled or made up at a later date.

Arrival, Departure & What To Bring

Check-In Policy:

When arriving at Meadowmere Park, please stop at the Gatehouse and tell them you are a part of the Archery Program and they will direct you on where to drop off your child. (mostly likely in North Camping area) Please make sure you know your "secret password" before you leave your child. If you forgot your password you can ask the Archery Instructor at check-in. The City of Grapevine requires staff and volunteers to go through background checks before being apart of any programs. Parents are welcomed to enjoy Meadowmere park, watch the league from a far or leave and come back for pick-up.

Check-Out Policy:

When leaving the Archery Program your child will be released only into the care of their parent, legal guardian or other designated adult. Before you pick up your child, you will be required to say your "secret password" this password was set during the registering for the program. Your child will not be released to an individual for any reason without the password.

What to Bring:

Please have your child wear closed-toed shoes.

Please bring a water bottle for your child to have during class – class is outdoors and water is important.
