Dove Creek Day Camp Behavior Guidance Policy

At Dove Creek Day Camp, we strive to create a safe, engaging, and enjoyable experience for all campers. To achieve this, we ask that campers conduct themselves in a manner that promotes their own well-being, respects others, and supports the camp staff in maintaining a positive environment. This policy ensures the safety and well-being of all participants and staff at Dove Creek Day Camp.

Parents/guardians are encouraged to review this Behavior Guidance Policy with their camper(s) to help ensure a successful camp experience for everyone. Our camp staff is dedicated to supporting and guiding campers through positive role modeling, encouragement, and adherence to established safety protocols, including behavior management strategies.

Expected Behavior

- Campers should remain respectful and considerate toward others.
- Campers must follow instructions from staff promptly to maintain safety and order.
- Participation in activities with a positive attitude is encouraged to ensure a fun and enriching experience.

Standard Disciplinary Measures

For minor behavior issues, the following steps will be taken:

- 1. Verbal Redirection Staff will address the behavior and provide guidance to the camper.
- 2. **Second Verbal Redirection** Further clarification and encouragement to correct the behavior.
- 3. **Temporary Removal from Activity** If the behavior persists, the camper will sit out of the activity, and parents/guardians will be informed.

Addressing Serious Incidents

If a camper's behavior jeopardizes their safety or the safety of others or violates the camper behavior contract, the following steps will be taken:

1. First Violation:

- The incident will be addressed, and the camper may be removed from the activity for the day.
- Parents/guardians will be contacted during or at the end of the camp day based on the severity of the incident.

2. Second Violation:

- Staff will address and document the behavior.
- Parents/guardians will receive a phone call and may be required to pick up the camper within the hour.
- The camper may not be permitted to attend the next scheduled camp day.

o Parents must sign an incident report at pickup.

3. Third Violation:

- Staff will address and document the behavior.
- o Parents/guardians will be contacted to immediately pick up the camper.
- o Depending on the severity, the camper may be suspended from camp for one week.
- o Parents must sign an incident report at pickup.

4. Fourth Violation:

 The camper will be dismissed from the camp program for the remainder of the summer.

Immediate Dismissal

At our discretion, any behavior deemed unsafe or harmful—whether physical, emotional, or otherwise—may result in the camper's immediate removal from the program.

By signing the Camper Behavior Contract, parents/guardians acknowledge that they have reviewed and discussed the expectations with their camper(s) and understand the consequences for failing to meet these guidelines.
